

## First Pride March



June 25, 1977

The first Pride march in France, organized in Paris, to commemorate the Stonewall riots and demand LGBTQ+ rights.

On Saturday, June 25, 1977, in Paris, a handful of demonstrators marched from the Place de la République to the Place des Fêtes. They were protesting against the repression of homosexuality and thus participating in the very first LGBT Pride March in France. At the time, the call to demonstrate had been issued by the Women's Liberation Movement (MLF) and the Homosexual Liberation Group (GLH). This Parisian demonstration was a reaction to the threats faced by homosexuals in the United States.
